Director's Note

Newsies is one of my all-time favorite musicals. Heck, it was one of my favorite movies growing up and helped me to not only fall in love with musical theater (and Christian Bale!), but it helped me to better understand and appreciate the concept of children's and workers' rights at a pretty young age. This show hits home some rather intense topics that can be hard to introduce to young audiences initially, but it's all wrapped up in a gorgeously harmonized package so it's a bit easier to grasp! ;)

This show does an incredible job of taking the historically accurate events of 1899 in New York City with regards to the Newsboys Strike and churning it out into an entertaining show that preserves the value of the lessons learned from that particular event while also stimulating audiences via beautiful music, showstopping choreography, and relatable (albeit partly-fictionalized) characters. I think this musical is an important part of our curriculum in the world of musical theater, and though I've seen it performed on the Broadway circuit a handful of times, I have learned more about the show and the events it's based upon over the past few weeks working on this production with my kidsActing students than my prior experiences combined. For that, I am truly grateful.

I am also wildly grateful to my fellow teaching artists who have worked on this show beside me. It has been a joy to work with Audrey Barrett, Toph Ehresman, Joshua Mason, and Emi Fifer on this production. Each of them brought something unique to the process that I cannot emulate, and therefore they have each made this show bigger and better than it could have possibly been under my care alone. I love and appreciate each one of you!

We could not do this show without the amazing parents of our students here at kidsActing. I appreciate your support over the past four weeks, and truly hope you enjoy this production and recognize how hard your children worked to put it together. It was not an easy feat, and yet they

MADI KENNEDY (MEDDA LARKIN) wants everyone to know that being big, beautiful, and powerful will change the century in the best ways!

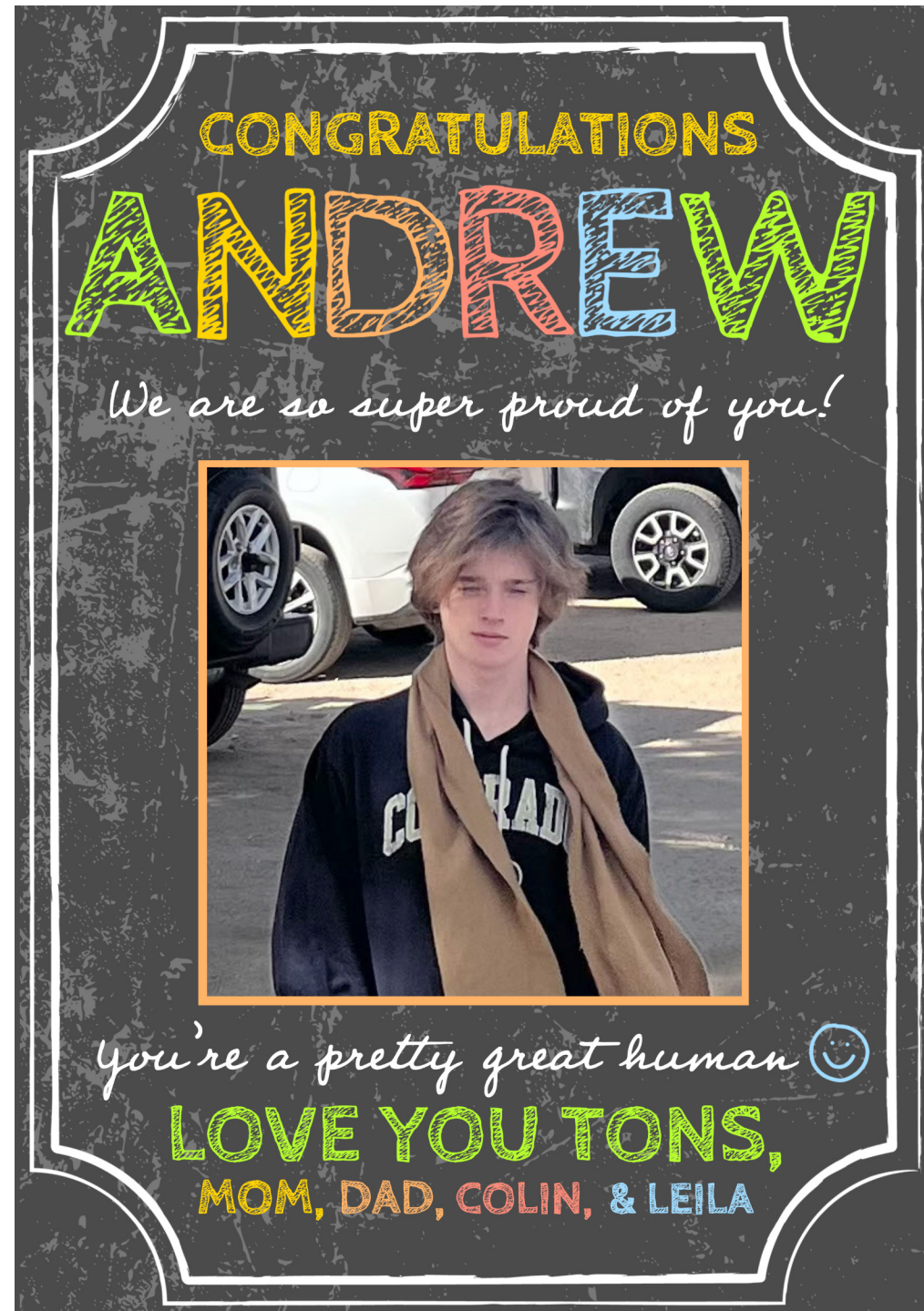
